children s publishing is a huge international industry and there is ever growing interest from researchers and students in the genre as cultural object of study and tool for education and socialization

the years 1830 1914 witnessed a revolution in the manufacture and use of books as great as that in the fifteenth century using new technology in printing paper making and binding publishers worked with authors and illustrators to meet ever growing and more varied demands from a population seeking books at all price levels the essays by leading book historians in this volume show how books became cheap how publishers used the magazine and newspaper markets to extend their influence and how book ownership became universal for the first time the fullest account ever published of the nineteenth century revolution in printing publishing and bookselling this volume brings the cambridge history of the book in britain up to a point when the world of books took on a recognisably modern form

analysing lewis carroll s alice books in the context of children s literature from the seventeenth through the nineteenth century ronald reichertz argues that carroll s striking originality was the result of a fusion of his narrative imagination and formal and thematic features from earlier children s literature the making of the alice books includes discussions of the didactic and nursery rhyme verse traditionally addressed by carroll s critics while adding and elaborating connections established within and against the continuum of english language children s literature drawing examples from a wide range of children s literature reichertz demonstrates that the alice books are infused with conventions of and allusions to earlier works and identifies precursors of carroll s upside down looking glass and dream vision worlds key passages from related books are reprinted in the appendices making available many hard to find examples of early children s literature

this historic book may have numerous typos and missing text purchasers can usually download a free scanned copy of the original book without typos from the publisher not indexed not illustrated 1884 edition excerpt the subject was fully appreciated but that its great magnitude would necessarily require some time for maturing the plans essential to securing its complete success his royal highness communicated that he had also requested mr labouchere as president of the board of trade to give his consideration to this subject mr labouchere was now at osborne and his royal highness expressed his desire that he should be present at this meeting mr labouchere was accordingly invited to be present his royal highness gave it as his opinion that it was most important that the co operation of the government and sanction of the crown should be obtained for the undertaking but that it ought to be matter for serious consideration how that co operation and sanction could be most expediently given mr labouchere stated that the whole subject would have the very best consideration he could give it and on behalf of the ministry he could promise an early decision as to the manner in which they could best give their co operation he suggested that if instead of a royal commission being formed to include some of the chief members of her majesty s government those same ministers were to be elected members of a managing committee of the society of arts this object might perhaps be as well accomplished it was explained to mr labouchere that the exertions of the society of arts would be given to the undertaking to the utmost extent to which they could be useful but that these functions would necessarily be of an executive and financial nature rather than of a judicial and legislative character it was further urged by three members of the society that one of the requisite conditions for the acquirement of public confidence was that the body to

victorian alphabet books and the education of the eye shows how the familiar genre went beyond mere reading instruction to offer nineteenth century british writers illustrators and publishers a site for representing and re thinking literacy itself this interdisciplinary study traces how individuals throughout the victorian era deployed alphabet books to promote visual literacy or oral culture as a vital complement to textual literacy their strategies ranged from puns and political allusions to elaborate designs that addressed adult audiences alongside or even instead of children as the format became more familiar in the first part of victoria s reign george cruikshank william makepeace thackeray henry cole and edward lear were

quick to recognize its critical potential this history pivots around the mid 1860s and 1870s when the production of illustrated alphabet books exploded thanks to evolving printing technology and national education reform case studies of individual works and makers show how a revolution in picture books reflected and responded to laws assuring children's access to schooling on the one hand socialist artist walter crane was able to develop alphabetical illustration from a utilitarian mid century product into an aesthetically rich yet accessibly priced education of the eye on the other hand kate greenaway hablot knight browne phiz and their publishers tended to leverage commercialized nostalgia against pedagogy this survey concludes by showing how market oriented trends and the development of photographic reproduction toward the end of the century fed into interpretations of the alphabet including works by rudyard kipling and hilaire belloc that reflected growing ambivalence about industrialized print culture
